# **AUSTRALIAN POTASH LIMITED** ISSUE OF OPTIONS AND PERFORMANCE RIGHTS

Australian Potash Limited (ASX: APC) (APC or the Company) advises that, pursuant to the Notice of Annual General Meeting lodged with ASX on 27 October 2020 and the subsequent approval by shareholders at the Annual General Meeting held on 25 November 2020, the Company has issued the following unquoted securities:

- 750,000 unlisted options exercisable at \$0.175 each on or before 29 July 2023 to Ms Cathy Moises, a non-executive director of the Company
- 750,000 unlisted options exercisable at \$0.175 each on or before 29 July 2023 to Mr Brett Lambert, a non-executive director of the Company
- 1,408,623 performance rights to Mr Rhett Brans, an executive director of the Company, of which:
  - o 469,541 performance rights (Tranche A) vest on the Company completing its FEED Study for the Lake Wells Sulphate of Potash Project (LSOP):
  - o 469,541 performance rights (Tranche B) vest on a final investment decision to develop the LSOP; and
  - 469,541 performance Rights (Tranche C) vest on the commencement of commercial production of the LSOP.


